To combat this, we have started a large-scale effort to establish RO and clean water facilities across Karachi, ensuring easy access to clean water for all.

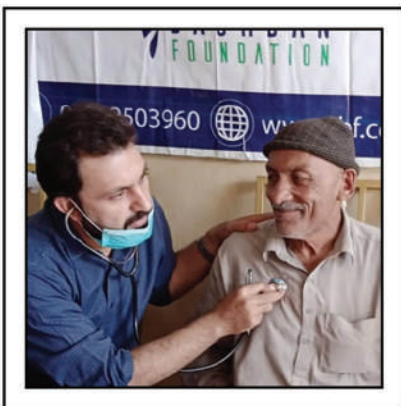

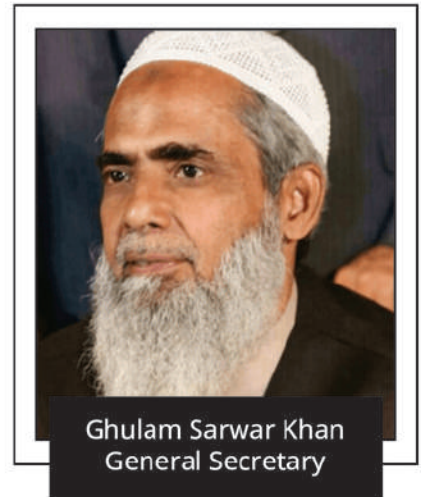
